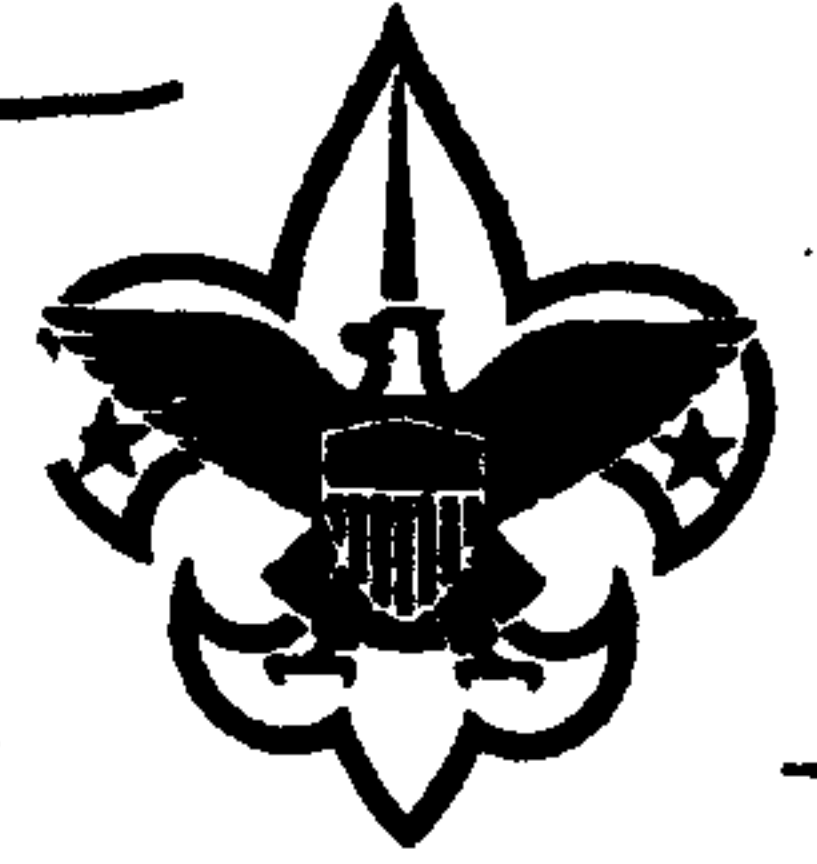


Webelos-to-Scout Transition

OBJECTIVES:

- **Complete Webelos Badge and Arrow of Light Requirements by February (Blue and Gold Dinner)**
- **Hold Webelos-to-Scout Bridging Ceremony in February (at Blue and Gold Dinner) or March**

NEXT STEPS:

- **Review Arrow of Light and Boy Scout Joining Requirements with Webelos, including:**
 - Demonstrate Scout Sign, Salute, and Handshake
 - Demonstrate tying a square knot
 - Understand and agree to live by the Scout Oath, Scout Law, Scout Motto, Scout Slogan, and Outdoor Code
 - Describe the Scout Badge
 - Visit a Boy Scout Troop Meeting and Outdoor Activity
 - Participate in a Scoutmaster Conference
- **Transform the Webelos Den to a Webelos Patrol**
 - Have the Den select a Scout Patrol name, get Patrol patches to wear on brown shirts (ditch the blue Cub Scout shirts, if possible), make a Patrol flag, and elect a Patrol Leader
 - Contact local Troops for Webelos Den Chiefs
- **Contact local Troop(s) for Webelos/Troop Camping Dates**
- **Encourage Webelos to visit the local Boy Scout Troop(s)**
 - Visit as a Webelos Den or individually, with parents
 - Plan to visit the Pack's associated Troop, plus one or two other local Troops
