1. Become recognized as a BSA Certified Angling Instructor an Official
2. Train the Trainer Certification CS-61. Receive a CAI patch and Certificate.
3. Learn basic fly-fishing skills - fly casting, fly tying, knots and how to teach them. Receive electronic copies of the Power Point slides and access to the CAI Official Website for additional support and materials.
