### January 5, Friday:



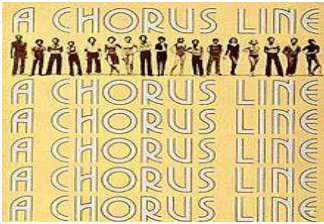
### Eagle Scout Class of 2017 Recognition and Dinner.

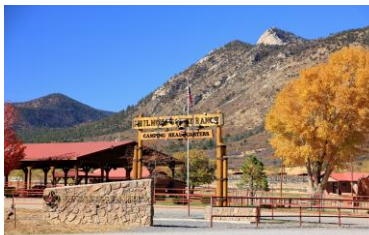
**August 18, Saturday: Bethlehem, PA Trip.**
