**Suggested Timetable for Family Scouting Cub Scout Packs:
Existing Packs Recruiting Girl Cub Scouts into All-Girl Dens**

[NOTE: A BSA-registered female, 21-years of age or older, **MUST** be present at any activity involving girls.]

Timing	Activity
April - September	Pack leadership must contact its Chartered Organization for approval to recruit girls into the current Pack. Together they must complete a "2018/2019 Cub Scout Pack Designation Form" and forward it to Patriots' Path Council before beginning any recruiting for girls.
	After forwarding Chartered Organization approval to PPC, the Pack can conduct spring recruiting for girls and boys, or can wait and conduct fall recruiting.
May-June	Spring recruiting can occur, and the new all-girl Dens and all-boy Dens can start on their Cub Scout Adventures for the next rank level, as soon as school is out. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • K-4 recruited in the spring will be Tiger-Arrow of Light Scouts, as soon as they move to their upcoming grades of 1-5. • Pre-K spring recruits will be Lions when they move up to Kindergarten.
	Girl and boy spring recruits must be registered in the BSA immediately.
	Newly recruited Pack Leaders and Den Leaders must take Youth Protection Training online or in person and be registered in the BSA immediately.
June-August	Girl and boy spring recruits going into grades 1-5 in the fall can attend Cub Scout Day Camp as Cub Scouts.
	Girl and boy spring recruits can participate in the Pack Summertime Award program.
Aug-Sept	Fall recruiting can occur, and the all-girl Dens and all-boy Dens can immediately start on their Cub Scout Adventures. K-5 can be recruited during the Fall Recruiting effort. They will be Lion-Arrow of Light Scouts as they start their program year.
	Girl and boy fall recruits must be registered in the BSA immediately.
	Newly recruited Pack Leaders and Den Leaders must take Youth Protection Training online or in person and be registered in the BSA immediately.
May - December	Cubmaster and Den Leaders for the all-girl Dens should take Cub Scout Leader Position-Specific Training to be best prepared to run a quality program; other Pack Leaders and Den Leaders are encouraged to do the same. Training courses will be offered 8/25, 10/2, 12/1, and other dates TBD, and on request to the PPC Training Committee. [Go to PPCBSA.org, click on Programs, then select Training from the drop-down menu and look at the Cub Scout section.]
	All-girl Dens can begin with fewer than 4 girls if necessary; all-boy Dens can begin with fewer than 4 boys if necessary.
