Summer Camp Site Reservation Policy

Next year reservations - Units attending camp this summer

- Any units camping with us have the right of first refusal for their current campsite for similar dates the following summer. Please check the dates on the future year's reservation form as they may change from year to year. If a unit does not reserve their site and week for the following year before summer camp checkout, the site becomes available for any unit to reserve on a first come, first serve basis.

To reserve a site for next summer:

- Complete and submit the *Summer Camp Site Reservation and Payment Form* prior to leaving camp. A \$250 non-refundable deposit must accompany the form.
- Hand the form to the business manager. They will place the date and time of receipt on the form which will be used to resolve any conflicts.
- For units desiring a change of week, site or camp, please indicate your preferences on the form.

New units - making a reservation

- Reservations are accepted at any time - complete and submit the *Summer Camp Site Reservation and Payment Form* to the council office.
- A \$250 non-refundable deposit must accompany the form.

Reservations for returning units are given priority for the same site and dates in the following year. If a unit does not reserve the site before checkout, it becomes available for any unit to reserve on a first come, first serve basis. Check the site availability charts at www.ppcbsa.org

Campsite capacities

- We will do our best to keep one unit to a site. If your total attendance projection and/or actuals are less than the minimum capacity of your reserved site, we may place additional unit(s) in your site to maximize the camp's total capacity. You will receive communication from the Patriots' Path Council before such accommodations are made. Site capacities (including minimum and maximums are noted on the site availability chart online)

Changing site or week - Any unit requesting a change in week, site, or camp, may submit an updated site reservation form at any time. Please be sure to include your preferences. Sites will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis.
