Dan Beard is our superb first year camper program. Scouts have fun learning and practicing Scout skills needed for Tenderfoot through First Class ranks. They can also work on age appropriate merit badges.

Trailblazer Day Camp is for both first-year and experienced higher-ranking Scouts. Scouts can work on rank advancement, merit badges, and participate in high adventure programs. Camp runs Monday to Friday from 8:45 am – 4:00 pm. Free busing is available from many locations throughout Morris, Sussex and NW Somerset counties.

The **Ernest Thomson Seton** program is designed for Scouts who have completed Dan Beard or are looking to complete the last few requirements for First Class.





Scouts 14 years and older can participate in our all-terrain vehicle program. This BSA approved* program stresses both safety and fun.

Our extensive challenge course is the site of the **COPE and Climbing programs**. Learn to climb and rappel on the 48-foot climbing tower and try your skill on our natural rock face climbing areas.

Mountain biking is fun for both Scouts and leaders. We have daily treks that cater to all skill levels.

The **Shooting Sports** program includes rifle, shotgun, archery, and handguns.



Our Aquatics area offers merit badges such as Swimming, Lifesaving, Canoeing, Rowing, Kayaking and Small Boat Sailing. Don't miss the popular canoe wars or 14-foot iceberg!

Handicraft features a variety of merit badges in an environment perfect for hands-on creativity, and **Scoutcraft** offers several merit badges with something for everyone.

The **Ecology Conservation** program offers more than a dozen merit badges, hikes and more. Our **STEM** area offers science, technology, engineering and math programs, and Nova awards.
