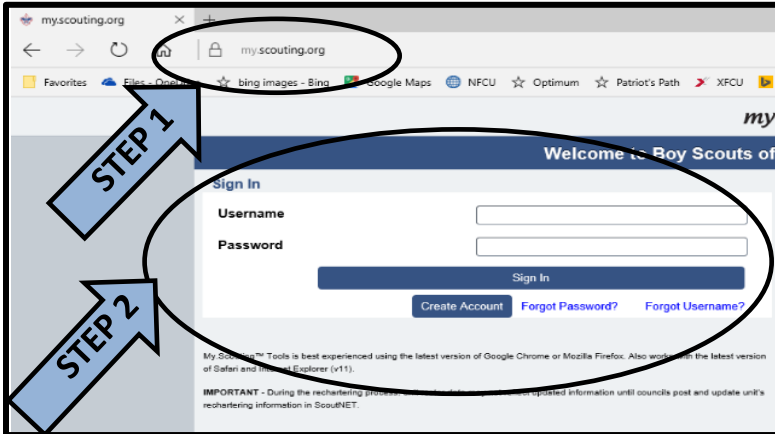

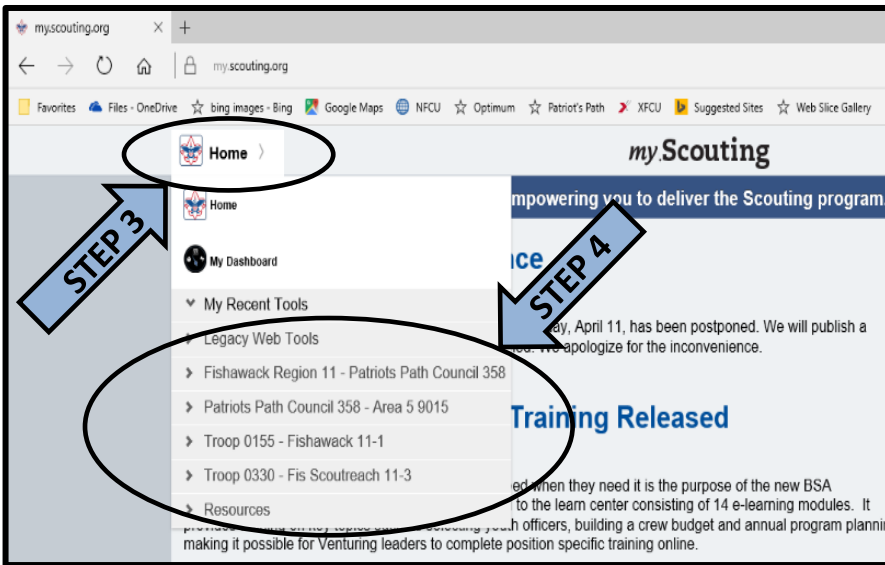

Unit Youth Protection Aging Report Instructions:



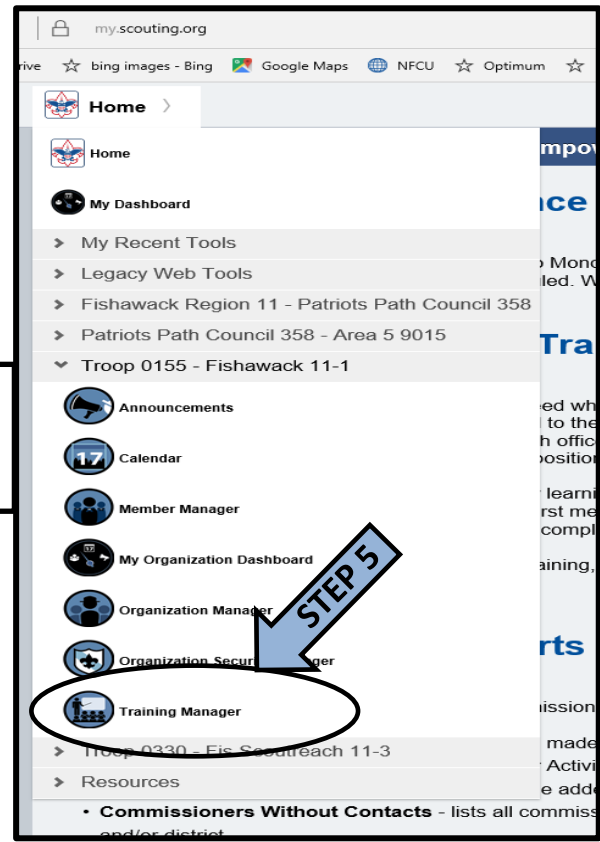
- 1: Navigate your way to url: www.My.Scouting.Org
