Camp Somers is located in beautiful and historic Mount Allamuchy Scout Reservation.

Camp Somers has been providing campers with lifetime memories for more than 75 years with a variety of camping options including four weeks of traditional day camp resident camp for troops. Scouts can enjoy activities such as climbing, ATVs and even make progress towards Eagle rank while at camp. Campers attending without their troop will be grouped together and form provisional camp troops.

Camp Winnebago

Winnebago Scout Reservation is one of the finest and longestrunning Scout camps in the USA. The reservation encompasses more than 450 acres of woodland for camping, hiking, and outdoor adventure. Durham Pond covers 60 acres for swimming, sailing, boating, and amazing bass fishing.

Winnebago has large, private campsites for a great summer camp experience. We are proud to offer four one-week sessions of resident camp to Scouts BSA with their troop or individually. Campers attending without their troop will be grouped together and form provisional camp troops.

SPECIALTY WEEKS

Specialty weeks are unique opportunities at our summer resident camps that offer a weeklong program built around a specific subject. Participants will have the option to attend individually or a Scout attending with their unit can sign up for a Specialty Week during their time at camp.

Fishing Camp WEEK 3

At this program, offered at Camp Somers, Scouts will earn Fishing, Fly Fishing and Fish and Wildlife Management merit badges. This camp will also have trips off site that will allow Scouts the opportunity to fish in different elements, such as a river, or from the beach.

Camp COLEY AUGUST 4th-10th

Camp COLEY is a weeklong overnight camp open to all youth entering grades 3-12. Held at Camp Somers, the focus is on lots of great fun and activities that camp Somers has to offer whether or not you are trying to earn a merit badge! Visit campcoley.com for more information.

Patrol Cooking WEEK 3

Units attending Camp Winnebago will have the option of selecting Patrol Cooking instead of dining hall meals, and camping in the South End. This is a great opportunity for a unit who wants to experience summer camp but would rather prepare their own meals in site to spend time bonding as a patrol and troop.

Skills & Trades Camp WEEK 4

This specialty week at Camp Winnebago will concentrate on skills such as carpentry, plumbing and electricity taught by professionals. Scouts will take what they have learned and spend the week focused on a building project.

Allamuchy Scout Reservation and Winnebago Scout Reservation, located in northern New Jersey, offer a combined area of over 1,400 acres of natural beauty. 
