### Requirements:

- Be an Eagle Scout residing in the service area of the Patriots' Path Council-BSA (NOTE: One's college choice is not subject to this geographic limitation).
- Be a graduating high school senior or an undergraduate college student not beyond one's junior year. (Note: Scholarship awardees may receive this scholarship once, only.)
- Have demonstrated strong leadership and a spirit of service to others in or outside of Scouting.
- A one-page statement is required of all applicants. This statement is limited to the space provided and must be in 12-point Times New Roman font. If these stipulations are deviated from, the application will not be considered further, regardless of content.
- NOTE: Enclose a stamped, self-addressed postcard with your application, which the ESAA Scholarship Committee will initial and return-mail to you, to confirm receipt of your application.

### Procedures:

The Eagle Scout who resides in the service area of the Patriots' Path Council and is applying for this scholarship must complete the application personally.

- Include only what is requested; do not provide materials (e.g., *biographies, resumes, or supplemental lists of activities*) not requested.
- Answer all questions on this application: Use only the space provided.
- Enter or type your answers directly on this form; *do not hand-write anything except signature.*
- Address and mail your completed application by November 1st to: PPC-ESAA Scholarship Committee, 1 Saddle Road Cedar Knolls, NJ 07927.

### Important Notes:

- All applications become the property of the ESAA Scholarship Committee and will not be returned.
- By December 15, the ESAA Scholarship Committee will notify those selected of its decision via letter. The list of selectees will be posted on the council website (ppbsa.org). No written notification will be sent to applicants except those selected.
- Submitting an application is not a guarantee of a scholarship award. ESAA Scholarship Committee decisions are final; there is no appeal process.
- Applications may not be hand-written.
- Applications must be mailed via U.S. Postal Service (no faxes, emails, or email attachments accepted).
