Care must be taken in listing service that is truly meaningful. Membership in an organization in and of itself is not meaningful. Committee or board membership might not be meaningful unless the individual makes a major impact on the success of a project or program. Service as the leader of a successful campaign is more meaningful than a large financial contribution.
