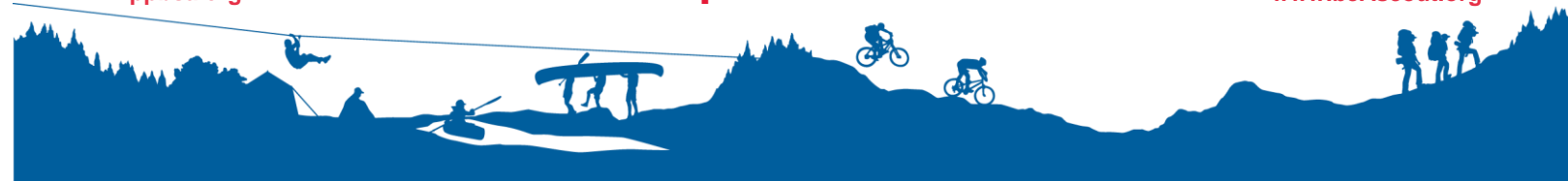

Pack Activities:
