What is NYLT?

NYLT is a rigorous youth leadership training program that provides skills for life and is designed to benefit and enhance the leadership teams of Troops and Venturers. It is fun, challenging and informative. The NYLT course centers on the concepts of what a leader must BE, what a leader must KNOW, and what a leader must DO. The key elements are taught with a clear focus on HOW TO. The skills come alive during the week as the participants go on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership. NYLT is a seven-day course. Content is delivered in a troop and patrol outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun, guiding environment. Interconnecting concepts and work processes are introduced early, built upon, and aided by the use of memory aids which allow participants to understand and employ this “Tool Box” of leadership skills much faster.

Who may attend NYLT?

-Registered Scouts BSA youth 13 years of age or completed the 7th grade until 18 years of age that have obtained First Class.

OR

-Registered Venture Scouts youth 14 years of age or completed the 8th grade until 21 years of age.
