

DISTRICT FALL RECRUITING CHAMPION

POSITION CONCEPT:

Fall Recruiting Champion is responsible to the District Recruiting Chair. The champion gives leadership to the development and implementation of the fall recruiting program.

PRINCIPLE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide leadership and assist the district implement the fall recruiting plan for Scouting as developed by the council and district membership committees.
2. Working with the district recruiting chair and district professional communicate with all packs in the district to secure participation in fall recruiting.
3. Provide leadership and support to packs' recruiting chairs.
4. Assist as need organizing recruiting trainings as well as be present to assist at the Tradeshow of Scouting with fall recruiting information and support.

Time requirement: Average 1-3 hours per week on average but up to several hours a week during the primary implementation period of August-September.
