- JOBS IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD OR TOWN

**TRIP TO THE FARM:** Cub Scouts sit in a circle and the first Cub Scout says, I took a trip to the farm and saw a \_\_\_\_\_. (First player names something that begins with an A. The player names something that begins with B. This continues on until the entire alphabet has been used.) If a player cannot name something that involves the farm with his/her letter, move on to the next

player. Set a time limit to name a person, place, or thing.

**BEAN AND STRAW RELAY:** You will need 15 beans, 2 containers and one straw per player. The beans need to be bigger than the straw for this to work. The first team to have all their beans in, wins.
