It is time again for the course no one else offers. This course, developed by Scouters from our council, is designed to increase your knowledge of the outdoors and the skills you need to keep your outdoor program exciting. It will provide a foundation for your unit's High Adventure program.

Registration is open to youth that are 13 years old and Star rank and above, Venturers, and to registered adult leaders. Space is limited so sign-up online as soon as possible. A list of equipment required can be found on the initial registration page. **An adult registered with their unit must accompany youth from a unit.**

Cost of this course is \$44.00 per Scout or adult if received by October 10, 2019 at 11:59PM. After October 10, 2019, the cost is \$54.00. No registrations accepted after October 17, 2019. All food and materials are covered in the fee. The course starts at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday. Friday arrivals are not possible. Please be in the main Winnebago Scout Reservation parking lot by 7:15 a.m. for a Caravan to the South End training area. This is an information packed demonstration course of advanced Boy Scout outdoor skills beyond basic First Class levels to enhance your troop's program. More than two dozen topics are covered and a reference CD is given upon completion. The "Thong" is held once a year, usually on the last weekend of October. 7:30 A.M. Saturday through Noon on Sunday. Meals are provided for in the course fee and participants campout Saturday night.
