## Exploring Youth Protection Online Training Instructions

### If you are a currently registered advisor...

1. Visit [www.myparticipation.org](http://www.myparticipation.org)
2. Sign in or create an account.
3. Choose Patriots' Path Council #358 as your council.
4. Please include your membership number in your profile.
5. Select E-learning from the left sidebar.
6. Scroll down and select Take Course next to Youth Protection—Exploring Version.
7. **Keep a copy of your certificate for your records. You may be asked to provide it in the future.**

### If you are a new advisor...

1. Visit [www.myparticipation.org](http://www.myparticipation.org).
2. Click create an account. Enter a user name. Select I am new and don't know my number. Fill in the form. Check your email for a link to verify your email.
3. Select a password.
4. Sign in with the user name and password just created.
5. Select E-Learning on left side bar.
6. Scroll down and select Take Course for Youth Protection—Exploring Version.
7. **When finished, print your personalized certificate and attach to your BSA application.**
